## Job duties and responsibilities

- Review any training gaps and ensure that a robust cross training plan is in place within the team. Organise relevant training and coaching sessions with your team and ensure that all training documentation is completed and filed in a timely manner.
- Lead the implementation of continuous improvements in your area and continually improve communications through delivering the utilisation of all other relevant CI tools.
- Foster a team culture where standardised procedures are adhered to at all times.
- Co-ordinate the day to day activities to ensure production metrics/targets are met consistently communicate performance through tier process.
- Promote a safety culture within your team through leading by example and ensuring that all Health & Safety procedures/cultures are adhered to and EHS regulatory compliance standards are met.
- Promote the escalation of safety incidents, near misses and good saves within your team.
- Co-ordinate and strive to meet excellent GMP/GDP and housekeeping to ensure excellent standards are maintained.
- Assist in the measuring, monitoring and control the key parameters that drive the team's performance in its KPIs as agreed with the Production Manager.
- Raise awareness among your team of the actions they can undertake to deliver improvements in this area e.g. Housekeeping, consumable usage, NCR reductions etc.
- Give clear and consistent guidance and communication to your team on production plans, timelines and quality expectations.
- Promote a culture of excellence by ensuring all product is made to defined quality standards and meets the customer specifications;
- Ensure that the audit standard is maintained on an ongoing basis;
- Ensure all product is processed in accordance with customer specs;
- Delivery of Key Performance Indicators for the area and report on performance of the department with respect to these KPI's on a consistent basis.
- Timely identification and resolution of process and production related problems to ensure downtime is minimised and output volumes are met.
- Completion of work to tight deadlines without comprising on quality of output.

- Development of effective relationships within your team and across all other departments as required.
- Assist in the identification and Implementation of solutions for internal and external customers within appropriate timelines.
